

Policy 3.4 Privacy Policy

FuseSocial is committed to protecting the privacy of the personal information of its employees, volunteers, community partners, and other stakeholders. We value the trust of our partners and the public, and we recognize that keeping this trust means we must be transparent about how we treat the information you choose to give us.

During the course of our projects and activities, FuseSocial frequently gathers personal information to use. We promise that we will only use this information with your consent, we will inform you of how we intend to use this information, and we won't share that information without your permission.

What is personal information?

Personal information is any information that can be used to distinguish, identify or contact a specific individual. This includes their comments, beliefs, or any facts related to the individual. We consider donor and volunteer information to always be personal information, and we do not disclose information about donors or volunteers without consent.

What is public information?

This does not include publically available information, such as information in telephone directories, or business contact information. Information which is already available in the public domain is not covered by our privacy policy.

Where the people we have contact with use their home contact information as business contact information, we consider that contact information as business contact information. It is not therefore as protected as personal information. We still promise to not abuse your information.
